A DEFAULTER ARRESTED.

THE DEFAULTING TOWN CLERK AND TREASURER OF METHUEN RETURNS AND IS ARRESTED.

LAWRENCE, MASS., APRIL 19.—Charles S. Whittier, the defaulting Town Clerk and Treasurer of Methuen, who absconded Feb. 8, taking \$12,000 of the town's money, was arrested this afternoon in Methuen. It was ascertained he had come to town last night. A watch was placed on his wife's residence and he was seen through the window. He appears broken down mentally and presented a pitiable appearance. He gives no definite account of where he has been, but says he has been where United States officers could not arrest him. He came home because he was tired of wandering. Efforts will be made to effect a compromise with the town officials. Whittier was allowed to remain at his residence, but is under police surveillance.
